




The 'zipper' merge on Lions Gate Bridge: An example of Canadian politeness.







IN CONGRESS, JULY 4, 1776. ADECLARATION BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

IN GENERAL CONGRESS ASSEMBLED.

HEN in the Coarfe of human Events, it becomes need they for one People to dissolve the Political Bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the Powers of the Earth, the separate and equal Station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent Respect to the Options of Mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them




