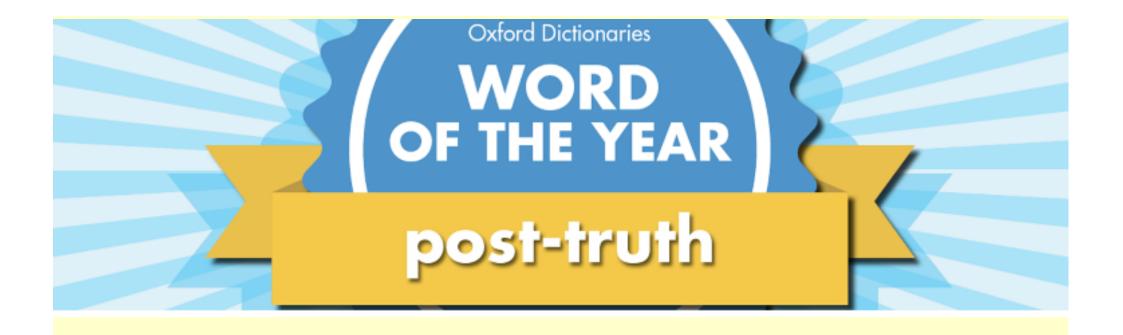

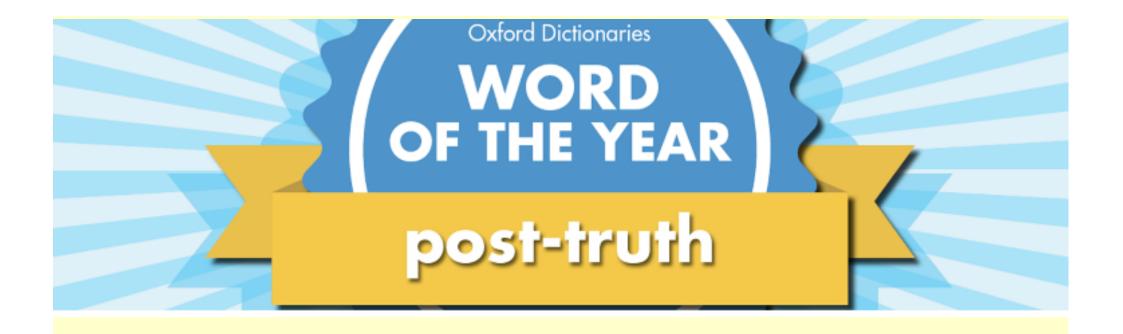

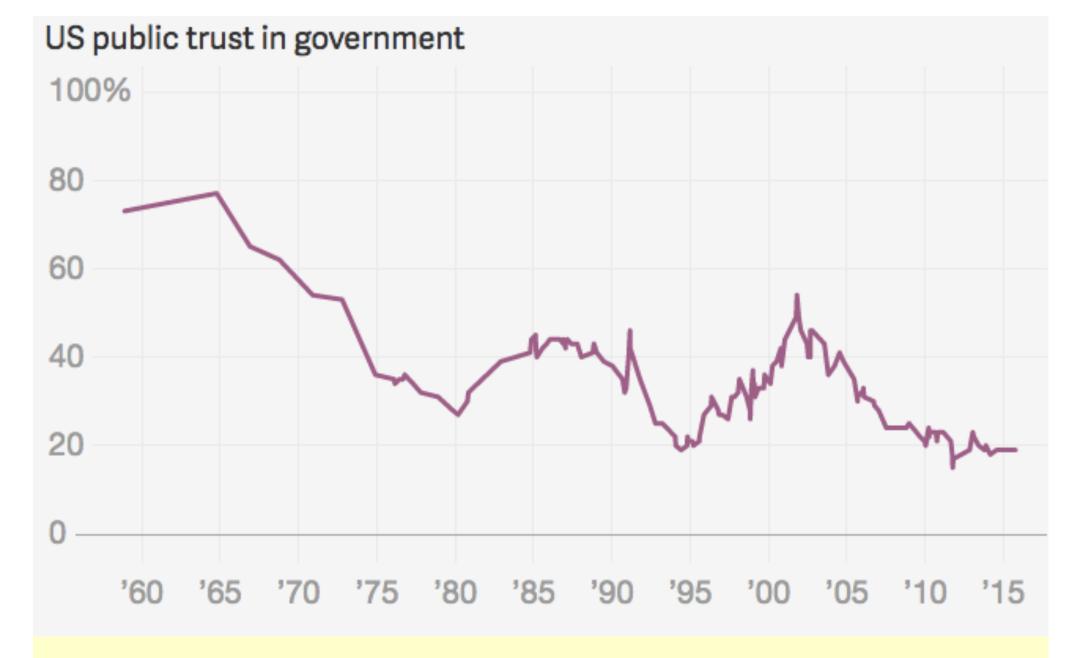
#### Definition

"circumstances in which objective facts are less influential in shaping public opinion than appeals to emotion and personal belief."

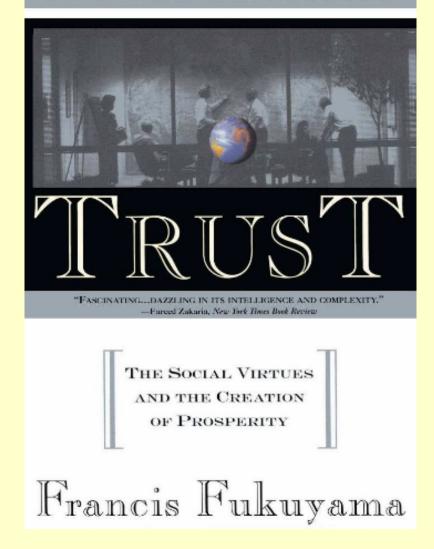


### Example

 Regulations and guidelines produced by the QA agency

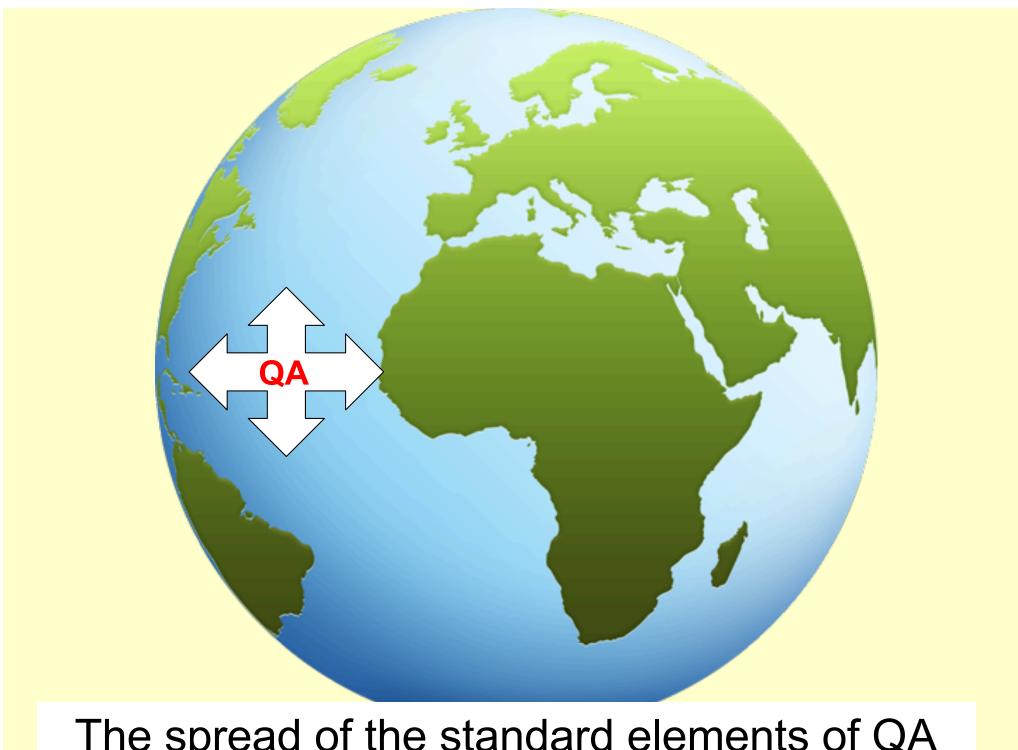
 A self-evaluation prepared by the institution

 Appointment of a peer group to review the self-evaluation









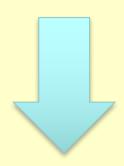
The spread of the standard elements of QA

 An outcomes-based external review of alternative providers of higher education for their performance and quality

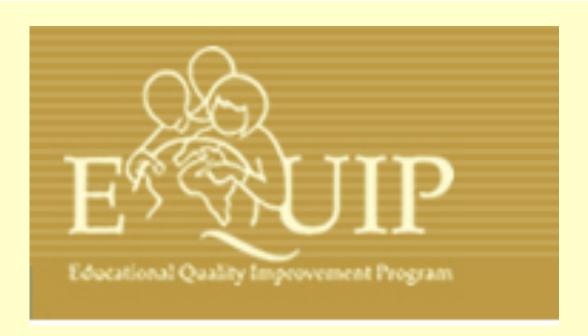
Can be used nationally or internationally



Sent an application to CHEA to be a Quality Platform Pilot (June 2015)

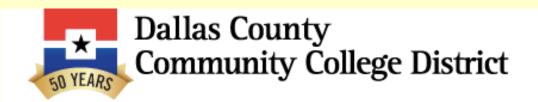
Prepared a Self-Review and sent it to CHEA (September 2015)

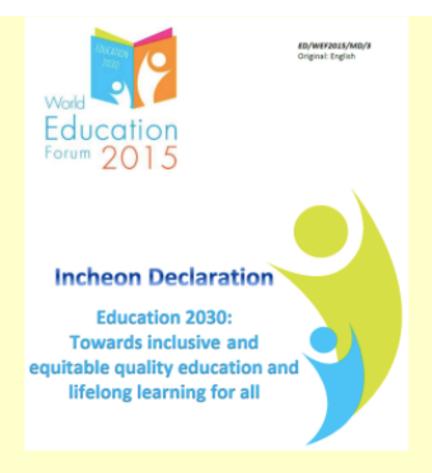

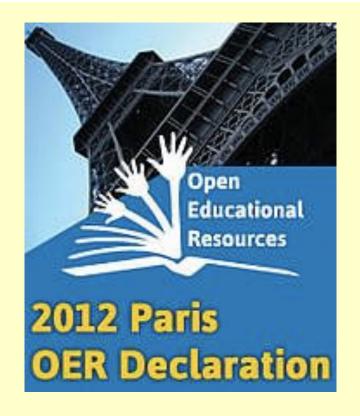


# Online & Open

- Open source software
- Open access to research results/data
- Open Educational Resources



'a well-established properly regulated tertiary education system, supported by technology, open educational resources and distance education can increase access, equity, quality and relevance'



'Governments can create substantial benefits for their citizens by ensuring that educational materials developed with public funds be made available under open licenses (with any restrictions they deem necessary) in order to maximize the impact of the investment.'



- Assess progress of OER
- More effective monitoring
