LESSON 1


- You need ASYNCHRONOUS online courses as well as SYNCHRONOUS online courses (more flexible for professors, more useful for students)

- Keep video lessons short (10-15 minutes)


What lessons from teaching classes LIVE on Zoom etc.?

 Use every possible mechanism to increase the intensity and quality of your INTERACTIONS with students.


(Students may be disoriented by independent study and will miss interaction with other students — project student services into their homes.)






Synchronous and ASYNCHRONOUS
