




Secondary:

2006 400 million out of school 2018 200 million out of school





# The Iron Triangle ACCESS QUALITY COST








### Distance Education at Scale – Three successful examples

### **Higher Education:**

The UK Open University ~200,000 students; 5,000 part-time tutors; 2,500 full-time staff

### **Secondary Schooling:**

National Institute for Open Schooling ~2 million students (350,000 annual admissions); 250 central staff; 3,260 study centres

### **Continuing Education:**

FutureLearn ~12 million users; 130 central staff; 250 partner institutions









